### **Honorable Directors**

The Moscow Declarations of November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020, signed by the heads of the SCO and BRICS member states, and the Agreements on cooperation in the field of physical culture and sports, signed in 2019 by the heads of the SCO member states and earlier by the heads of the CIS member states, provide for the holding of international sporting events. These documents are the basis for the further prospective development of partnerships in the field of physical culture and sports among the member states of the CIS, SCO and BRICS.

As part of the Moscow Declarations, the Expert Council on Physical Culture and Sports under the Federation Committee of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation on Social Policy, including the CIS Business Development Center, SCO Palace of Culture and OGFSO "Yunost-Russia", the Russian Sports Industry, the Russian Union of Martial Arts - advice and assistance to the Organizing Committee in the preparation and holding in the Russian Federation of the Second Eurasian club football tournament among the youth team football clubs of Hero Cities, the cities of Military Glory of Russia, the CIS, the EAEU and the SCO for the Eurasia and SCO Cup, dedicated to the 76<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Victory of the Soviet people in the Great Patriotic War 1941-1945 and the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of the Commonwealth of Independent States and the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the establishment of the SCO.

The Russian Football Union should include this tournament in the schedule of the RFU and in the Unified Schedule of the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation for 2022 after the submission of the relevant documents from the organizing committee to their address.

In the hero city of Moscow from June 26<sup>th</sup> to July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022, on the football fields of Luzhniki FC FSM, it is planned to hold a football tournament among youth club football teams (born in 2007) PFC of the CIS and SCO member states for the CIS Cup and SCO.

The Russian Football Union in its letter No. 1822 dated 21.08.19 notes that "this tournament should certainly become traditional and annual."

The tournament will be attended by 16 teams from the CIS and SCO countries, which will be divided into four subgroups.

JSC Luzhniki, in its letter No. 2696 dated 07.28.2021, is ready to provide 4 football fields for this tournament.

Dear Leaders, given the importance and significance of holding a youth football tournament in the hero city of Moscow from June 26<sup>th</sup> to July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Undoubtedly, your help and assistance will make a significant contribution to the development of youth football in the CIS countries and to the successful holding of this tournament in the hero city of Moscow from June 26<sup>th</sup> to July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
